RESPECT OTHER PEOPLE

- Please respect the local community and other people using the site.
- Don't block gateways, driveways or other paths with your vehicle.
- When riding a bike or driving a vehicle, slow down or stop for horses, walkers and farm animals and give them plenty of room.
- Stay within the site speed limit on permitted tracks, and don't ride 'off road'.
- Co-operate with people at work in the countryside and please follow directions from the ranger or person in charge.
- Leave gates as you find them or follow instructions on signs. When in a group, make sure the last person knows how to leave the gates.
- Leave machinery and farm animals alone – don't interfere with animals even if you think they're in distress. Alert the ranger instead.
- Use gates, stiles or gaps in field boundaries if you can – climbing over walls, hedges and fences will damage them.
- Our heritage matters to all of us – be careful not to disturb ruins and historic sites.

PROTECT THE NATURAL ENVIRONMENT

- Take care not to damage, destroy or remove features such as rocks, plants and trees. They provide homes and food for wildlife - This includes the collection and removal of wood for fires.
- Please be aware that nailing articles to trees causes damage.
- Please take your litter home with you, it can be dangerous to wildlife and farm animals. Dropping litter and dumping rubbish are criminal offences.
- Fires can be devastating to wildlife and habitats as well as people and property – so be careful with naked flames, camp fires and cigarettes at any time of the year.
- Keep dogs under effective control and clean up after them.
- Enjoy the outdoors and stay safe.
- Plan ahead and be prepared.
- Follow advice and local signs.
